

TROOP 54 LEADERSHIP AGREEMENT

In accordance with national BSA and Troop 54 policy, the Troop is led by its Scouts. In Troop 54, the adult leadership facilitates the Troop program, provides support and direction, in order to enable and support Scout leadership of the Troop. Therefore, when a Scout assumes a leadership position in order to advance beyond First Class rank, it is important that she understand the nature and quality of her individual commitment and the dedication needed to carry out her responsibilities.

Beyond First Class rank up to the Eagle rank, a Scout must make a commitment to her fellow Scouts and the Troop to be a leader. A Scout's service in a leadership position is a privilege, critical to the success of Troop 54 and is accepted on the terms of the following Agreement:

I understand a leadership position in Troop 54 is a privilege. I understand and agree to perform the duties and responsibilities of the Position of Responsibility known as _____, and to meet the expectations Troop 54 has for me. I also understand that in order to receive Leadership credit in Troop 54 for my services, I must meet all of the requirements and performance expectations signed off before having my Scoutmaster's Conference for my next Rank. I understand that I will be evaluated each month on my performance. I understand that I must have a journal of my experience in this Leadership position and that this journal must be brought by me to my Scoutmaster's Conferences. I understand that I must return the copy of the leader handbook issued to me at the end of my term. I understand that failure to meet the expectations, not setting a good example, or any disciplinary action may lead to my removal from my leadership position without any leadership credit applied towards my next rank.
